Netupitant/palonosetron (Akynzeo[®]▼) 300 mg/0.5 mg hard capsules

Submission by Chugai Pharma UK Ltd

Recommendation of AWMSG

Netupitant/palonosetron (Akynzeo[®]▼) is recommended as an option for restricted use within NHS Wales for the prevention of acute and delayed nausea and vomiting associated with highly emetogenic cisplatin-based cancer chemotherapy in adults. This recommendation applies only in circumstances where the approved Wales Patient Access Scheme (WPAS) is utilised or where the list/contract price is equivalent or lower than the WPAS price.

Netupitant/palonosetron (Akynzeo[®]▼) is not recommended for use within NHS Wales for the prevention of acute and delayed nausea and vomiting associated with moderately emetogenic cancer chemotherapy in adults.

In reaching the above recommendation AWMSG has taken account of the appraisal documentation prepared by the AWMSG Secretariat (reference number 1484), which includes the AWMSG Secretariat Assessment Report (ASAR), the Preliminary Appraisal Recommendation (PAR) and the applicant company's response to the PAR, clinical expert opinion (where available), the views of patients/patient carers (where available) and the lay member perspective.

This recommendation has been ratified by Welsh Government and will be considered for review every three years.
